Q: What is an E-Prescription?

A: Computer-generated prescriptions created by your doctor and sent directly to your pharmacy.

Q: What are the benefits of E-Prescriptions?

A: E-Prescriptions are:

- Fast - Your prescription arrives at your pharmacy before you leave your doctor's office.
- Convenient - You don't have to make that extra trip to drop off your prescription at the pharmacy.
- Legible - There is no handwriting for the pharmacist to interpret.
- Locations - Most of the pharmacies in the U.S. currently accept e-prescriptions.



Q: Will my prescription be ready when I arrive at the pharmacy?

A: Your prescription will arrive in the pharmacist's computer before you leave your doctor's office. However the time needed to prepare your prescription can be affected by the number of prescriptions in the pharmacy's computer, how quickly you arrive at the pharmacy after your doctor's visit, and how many people are already waiting at the pharmacy.
